INSIGHT FROM PAUL FOX

In June of 2022, Fox Group took delivery of two Volvo FE Electric 6x2 tippers. We were the first to take this step in the UK and the second in Europe. Although a **massive investment** for the company, the experience has been a learning curve—holding both advantages and disadvantages.

The **environmental benefits** of the trucks support our drive towards carbon net zero, which we have invested in heavily in the past couple of years.

Our **supply chain have also benefited:** with a lot of our contractors wanting the EV's working on their sites—ticking the box for their own carbon net zero policies. We know there is a definite drive within the construction industry for net zero.

However, as good as the wagons are for the environment; there are few challenges that come along with such a new development.

Ground clearance was an issue in the beginning; the batteries are low to the floor meaning access to limited sites, so it took meticulous planning. We had meetings when ordering the trucks to discuss range and expectations of the trucks, requiring them to do seven loads a day within 20 miles of our Leyland site, but, as many with electric vehicles may know, conditions must be perfect.

Range can be drastically reduced through hilly routes and adverse weather conditions, and with being in the UK, this isn't ideal. Wipers, heaters and lights all draw massively from the range, meaning that the trucks can't carry out their full days work, and we have to swap things round due to outstanding loads.

The **UK** charging infrastructure isn't ready for the government targets. We're struggling with queues for chargers at service stations nowadays, imagine trying to electrify our 300 trucks. It definitely doesn't seem possible within the next ten years.

To plan ahead for potential charging issues: we enquired about four additional chargers at our Leyland site, where the electric trucks are based. This would require us to upgrade our electricity supply which would have cost £40,000-£50,000. We run around 300 trucks and at the weekend and have about 160 wagons at Leyland, there's no way we could charge them all. We'll keep these tippers on the fleet for approximately three years before upgrading, hopefully things will have evolved.

We don't regret becoming an EV pioneer despite some of the hurdles we have faced.

We are keen for further development and will continue to evolve with the EV Wagons, making greener choices and having a **positive impact** on our environment.

Monitoring of fuel usage, driving behaviour and fleet efficiency is also required as proof of minimising the CO2 emissions on a month by month basis.

We regularly review our business operation and utilise various third-party sources including the Road Haulage Association, to ensure we keep up date with emerging environmental issues.

Our transport management system and vehicle tracking ensure our transport department operates efficiently, thereby reducing our environmental impact as well as providing an excellent service to our customers.

Recent acquisitions of several walking floor trailers have allowed the company to venture further into recycling and landfill contracting works. Further fleet expansion is planned for

FAIR CHANCE

We are proud to have developed a partnership with HMP Kirkham Prison to create 'The Fox Route' to employ ex-offenders. Each person who is accepted onto the programme receives **dedicated training** that covers health and safety as well as hands on training for the specific vehicle they will be operating. They must pass a theory and practical examination to gain their certification.

The Construction Plant Competence Scheme (CPCS) is a nationally recognised qualification that allows the individual to work on any construction site. This is a real transferable skill and a lifeline for many. Those who are successful will be paid at the same rate as any other qualified plant driver. The victim surcharge will apply. Fox Group will continue to support every individual upon release and will assist them in gaining further qualifications so they can become qualified to operate multiple vehicles.

INSPIRING THE YOUNG GENERATION

At Fox Group we are **keen to inspire our local younger** generation. By making visits to schools, as a local employer, we hope to connect and present the different options available to them after school. We understand how difficult it can be to choose a path after school therefore we are eager to share our experiences with the students in the hopes of making an impact.

We utilised existing railhead sidings within Leyland to create a greener alternative for haulage. The railhead sidings were initially built in 1953 and were relayed in 2018 for storage during the Blackpool electrification scheme.

> Utilising the railhead allows the group to further enhance sustainability initiatives. Rail allows larger amounts of material to be delivered in a much more efficient and greener way.

> > Typically rail haulage generates around 30% of C02 emissions of road haulage per equivalent journey - and nearly 90% less small particulate matter (PM10) and up to fifteen times less nitrogen oxide (NOx).

Local communities benefit from the reduced air and noise pollution as fewer trucks are passing through the towns. Railways are generally segregated from residential areas and take less land than roads.

We are making a conscious effort to cut our carbon emissions by using electric wagons, electric plants and now by utilising the railhead we are able to transport our aggregates in a much more sustainable way.

Not only has this helped our sustainability goals but it has kept the tradition of the Leyland railhead going and has brought a boost in business right across Lancashire and the local economy.

CREATING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

Sustainability is at t the heart of J.A Jackson's operations. Our washplant allows us to produce recycled aggregate at impressive rates. CDE designed us a solution which can process over 200tph, resulting in over 10,200 tonnes being washed through the plant each week.

The **200tph** solution integrates an EvoWash sand wash plant, AquaCycleTM A600 thickener, plus a R4500 primary scalping screen. A weekly tracker of the production is available on Fox Group LinkedIn!

In recent years we have a large demand for our recycled materials. Our single size aggregates and sand are extremely popular, we also produce a recycled Type 1 MOT from the clean oversize from the wash plant, giving a higher quality product when compared to dry processing. Trials have shown the quality to be equal to virgin materials. 85% of the feed material is re-purposed within the local construction industry, reducing the amount of waste sent to landfill.

Our facility has an abundance of **feed material from the local area**, much of
which comes from the 400 tipper wagons
which form part of the Fox Groups fleet.

The material is processed through the wash plant and the wagons leave with washed sand and aggregates, so as well as diverting material from landfill there are also less empty transport runs during this extremely efficient process, with waste washed and graded within 3 minutes.

We are located within 45 minutes from the local stone quarries in Cumbria so by increasing capacity we are helping further **reduce carbon footprint of material movements** by providing a source of aggregates to the local construction sector.




